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## California Gubernatorial Primary 2018 Analysis of the Hispanic Electorate

### Introduction

The current California population, according to the U.S. Census, is estimated to be over 39.25million people, of which close to 19 million (48.4%) are registered to vote, according to the California Secretary of State.

The U.S. Census also estimates that the California population is separated ethnically as Hispanic/Latino, 38.9%, White/Non Hispanic, 37.7%, Asian, 14.8%, Black/African American, 6.5%, and all Others, 2.1%.

Our previous voter analysis ([November 15, 2017 - California 2018 Gubernatorial Primary Analysis](#)) looked at an analysis of voter turnout projections based on past historical voting results of previous elections.

Similarly, this analysis will look back to our 2008 Hispanic voter analysis of voter turnout projections <http://datamar.com/pdf/cappvoteturnout2008.pdf> based on past historical voting results of previous elections.

This analysis will concentrate on the Hispanic vote in comparison to the total voting population, and also estimate the Hispanic voter turnout in California for the 2018 primary election.

### The Hispanic Voter – 25.65% of Registered Voters

Currently the California Secretary of State has 4,787,575 registered Hispanics (1) in its database, and 14,016,473 Non-Hispanics registered voters, which include White/Non-Hispanic, Blacks, African Americans, Asians, and Others. The Hispanic vote accounts for 25.6% of the total registered voting population and the Non-Hispanic accounts for 74.4%.

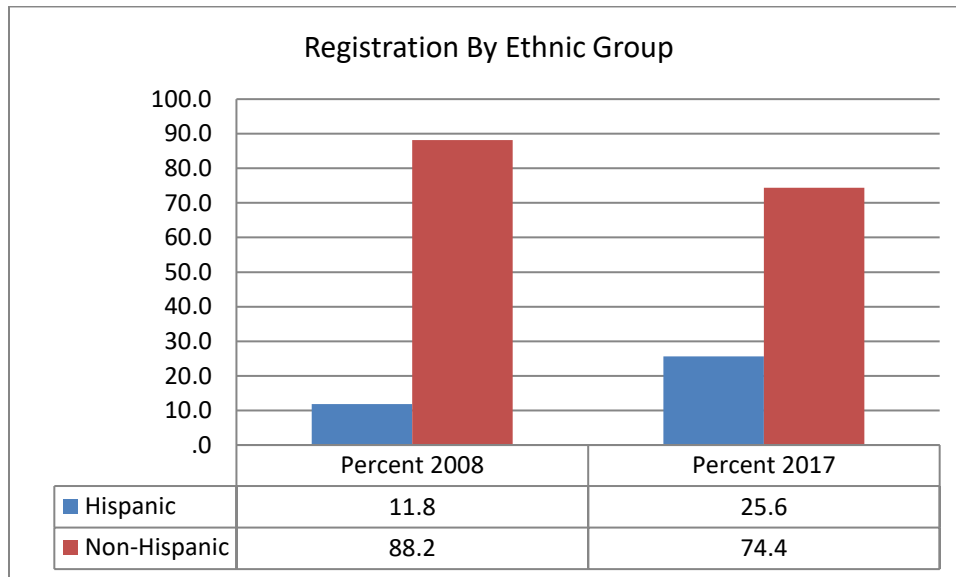
### Comparison of Hispanic Registration vs. Non-Hispanic Registration 2008 and 2016

The Hispanic voter registration has increased significantly since 2008 from 11.8%, 1,885,265 voters in 2008 to 25.6%, 4,787,575 voters in 2017.

The Non-Hispanic voter registration declined from 14,029,996, (88.2%), to 13,909,131, (74.4).

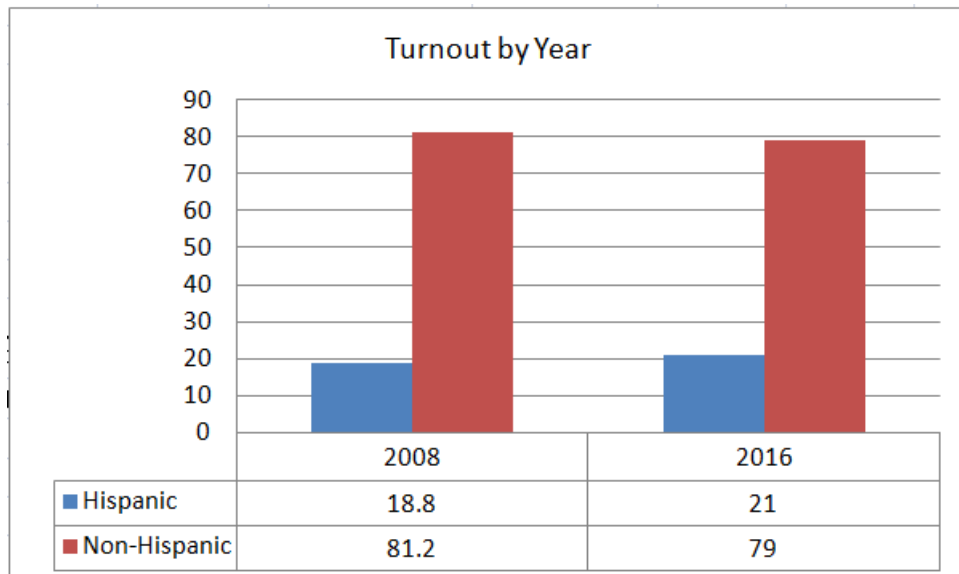
### Comparison of Hispanic Turnout vs. Non-Hispanic Turnout in 2016

The 21% of Hispanics that voted in the 2016 presidential election represent 1,716,030 million voters. The 79% of Non-Hispanic that voted represent 6,451,728 million voters for a combined total of 8,167,758 million out of an actual 18,696,706 million registered voters in the 2016 presidential primary.

The Hispanic voter turnout increased from 18.8% in 2008, to 21% in 2016.

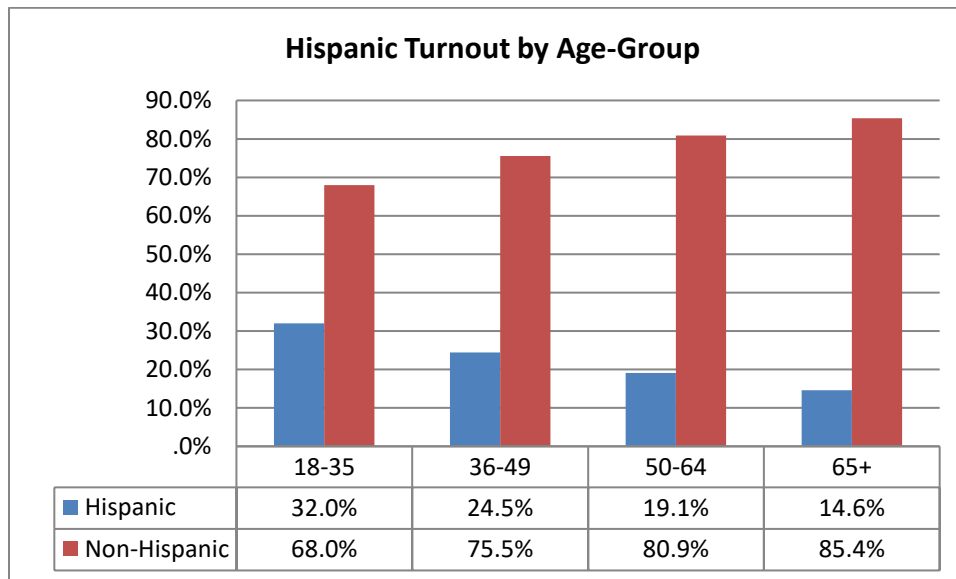


**Who are the 4.8 million Hispanic registered voters that turned out to vote in the 2016 presidential primary?**

Voter registration and voter participation have always differed due to a variety of factors beyond the careful planning of the political campaigns to figure out; as a casual glance at the California Secretary of State voter’s historical participation statistics shows.

The 1,716,030 Hispanics that turned out to vote in 2016 dominate the 18-35, with 499,688, (32.0%), and the 36-49, 353,048, (24.5%), second largest age-groups; the 50-64, 463,304, (19.1%), is the third largest and the 65+, 399,990, (14.6%), is the smallest turnout of all age-group.

The Non-Hispanic age-groups turnout increases as the group age increases.



**The 2016 Hispanic, Non-Hispanic voter turnout by age-group**

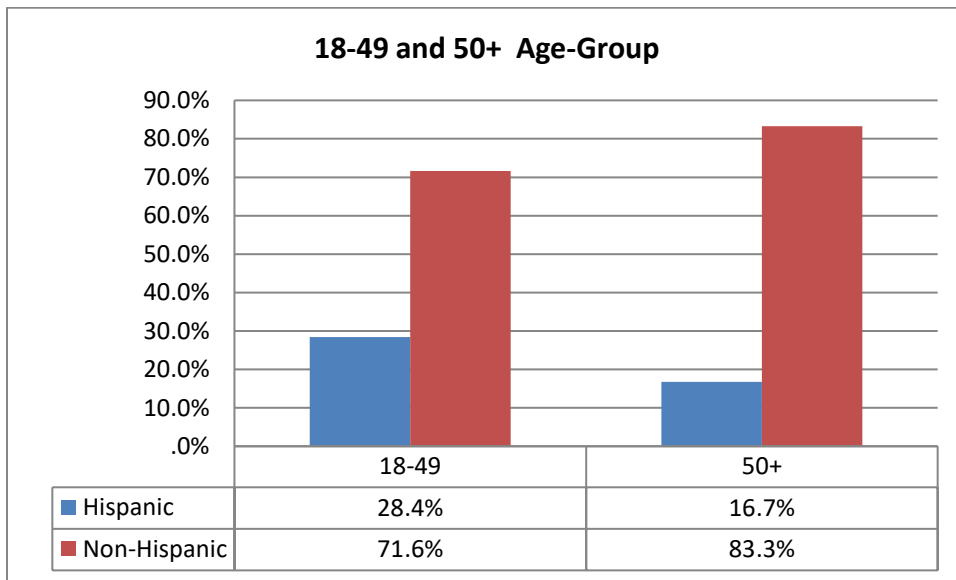

**The 2016 Combined Hispanic, Non-Hispanic voter turnout by age-group**

When merged into a combined age group, the 18-49 years-old group, 49.7%, is almost equal to the 50+ year-old groups, 50.3%. The Non-Hispanic is one-third, 33.3% of the 50+, 66.7%. The Non-Hispanic groups number of voters is not only significantly larger than the Hispanic but they outnumber them by more than 4.75 times.

The Hispanic active voting groups are relatively numerically equal in the combined age-groups, but not in their percentages. In comparison to the non-Hispanic voters they underperform in all age categories.

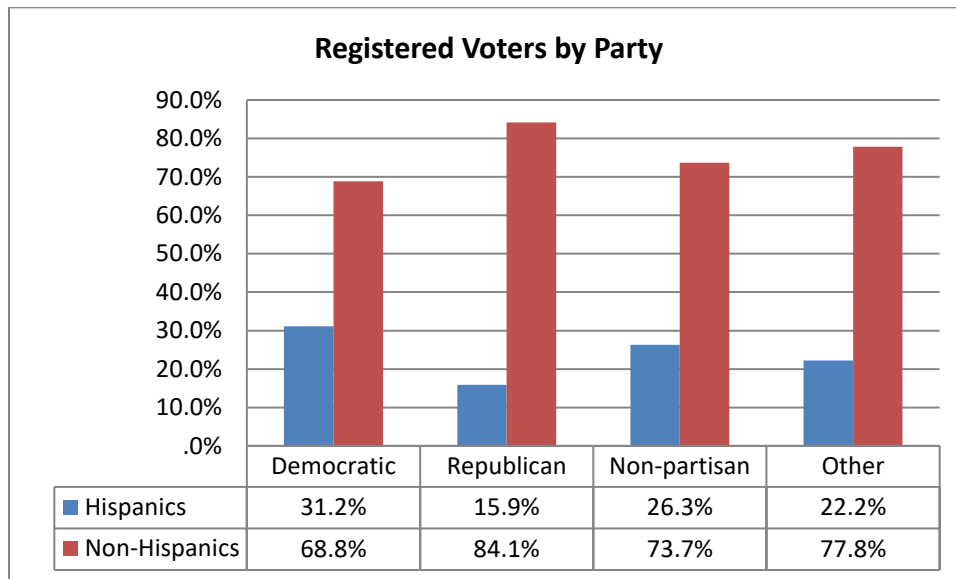
The 18-49 year-olds, 852,736 (28.4%), to the 50+ year-olds, 863,294 (16.7%); While the Non-Hispanic groups 18-49 year-old are 2,151,285 (71.6%) are numerically almost one-half the 50+ year-olds 4,300,443 (83.3%) numbers.

### Registered Voters By Party

The Democratic voter registration is 2,619,056 (31.2%) Hispanic and 5,788,301 (68.8%) Non-Hispanic; the Republican voter registration is 761,037 (15.9%) Hispanic and 4,039,236 (84.1%) Non-Hispanic; The Non-partisan voter registration is 1,208,265 (26.3%) Hispanic and 3,382,609 (73.7%) Non-Hispanic; the Other party voter registration is 199,217 (22.2%) Hispanic and 698,985 (77.8%) is Non-Hispanic.

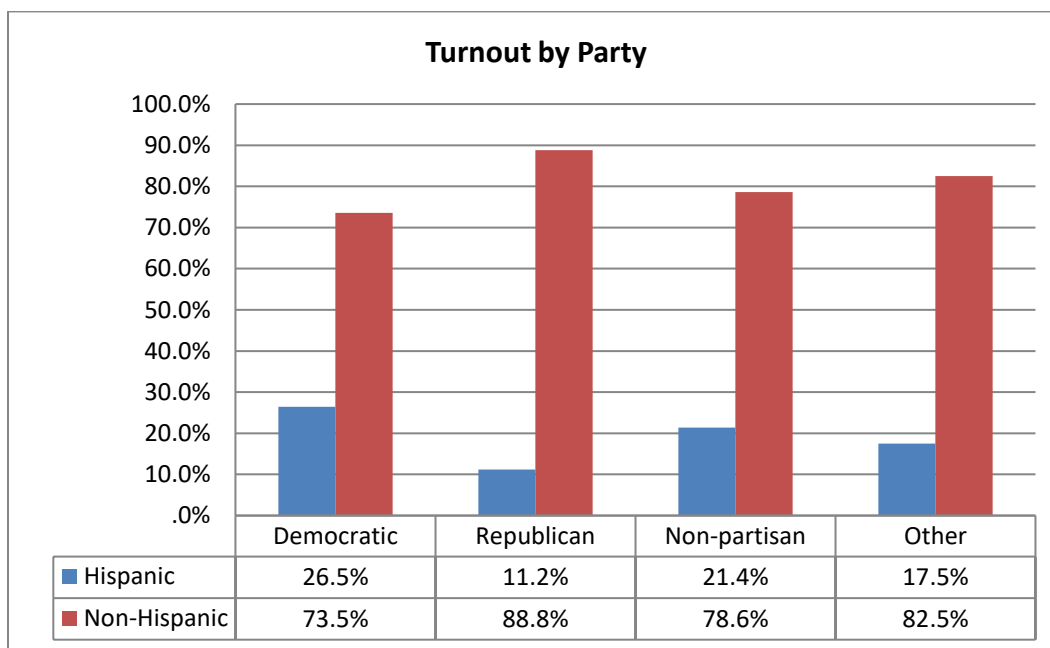


The total Hispanic registration of 4,787,575 voters accounts for 25.6% of all registered voters of the state's 18,696,706 voters.

**Hispanic and Non-Hispanic Partisan Active Voters.**

The contrast is more acute when we explore all Hispanic active voters. The Hispanics turnout in the Democratic Party is 1,135,397 (26.5%), the Republican Party is 261,214 (11.2%), the Non-partisan is 273,955 (21.4%), and all other parties is 45,464 (17.5%). The Non-Hispanic turnout also favors the Democratic Party at 3,155,737 (73.5%), the Republican Party at 2,075,464 (88.8%), the non-partisan at 1,006,184 (78.6%), and all other parties at 214,343 (82.5%).



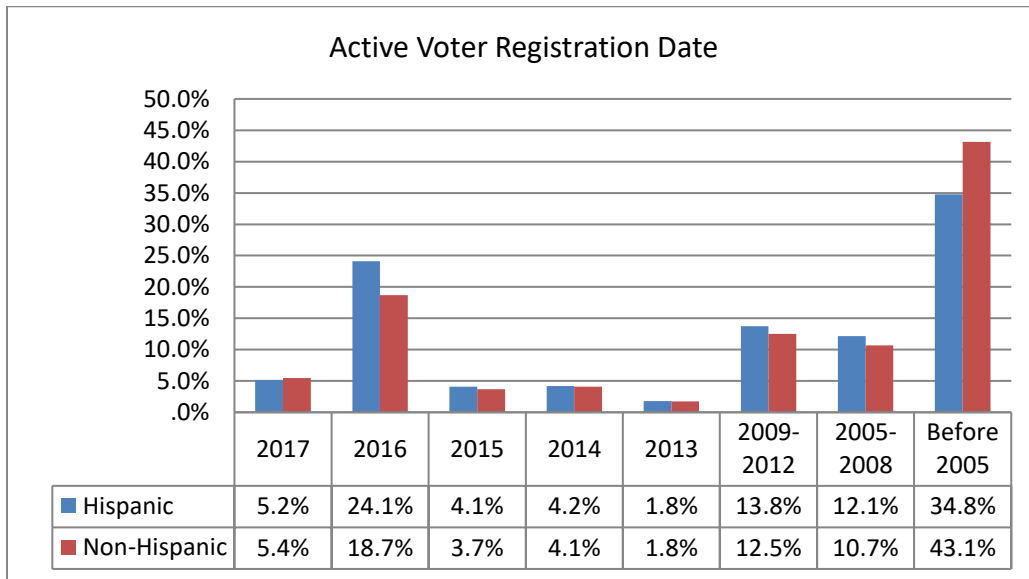
This table represents the numbers associated with the percentages of the graph above. The Hispanic total of the active partisan voting population is 1,716,030, or 21% of the total vote, and the Non-Hispanic active partisan voting population totals 6,451,728, or 79% of the total vote of 8,167,758.

### Active Voter Registration Date

The 2016 Presidential primary recorded a larger than normal increase in registration. Hispanic Registration went up by 24.1%, while Non-Hispanic registration rose by 18.7%. The upcoming 2018 gubernatorial election is showing a slight increase, though depending on the political climate, it has the potential of also increasing significantly.
